Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.

2. The present Writ Petition has been filed inter alia with the following prayer:

“On the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is therefore prayed that in the Interest of justice this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

i) Admit the Writ Petition;

ii) Call for the records;

iii) Direct the Opposite Parties to appoint to the petitioner in a suitable post as per the application submitted by the petitioner which is forwarded by the Headmaster of the School to the District Education Officer, Sundargarh on dated 06.07.2021 under Annexure-4(series) pursuant to the provision laid down in the Odisha Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme) Rules time to time with all service benefits within a stipulated period fixed by this Hon’ble Court.”

3. It is contended that even though application submitted by the Petitioner to get the benefit of appointment under Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme vide Annexure-4 series has been forwarded to



Opp. Party No.3 vide letter dated 06.07.2021 under Annexure-4 series, but no decision is being taken by the said Opp. Parties.

4. Learned Addl. Standing Counsel on the other hand contended that if the matter is pending before Opp. Party No.3 as found from Annexure-4 series, Opp. Party No.3 be directed to take a decision on the same.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the submission made, this Court while disposing the Writ Petition directs Opp. Party No.3 to take a lawful decision on the claim forwarded to him vide letter dated 06.07.2021 under Annexure-4 series in accordance with law within a period of two (2) months from the date of receipt of this order and intimate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

The Writ Petition accordingly stands disposed off.
