- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with T.R. Case No.09 of 2014 pending on the file of learned Addl. Dist. Judge-cum-Special Judge (Vigilance), Dhenkanal, arising out of Cuttack Vigilance P.S. Case No.61 of 2014 for commission of offences punishable under Section 13(2)/13(1)(d) of PC Act r/w Section 468/471/420/120-B of IPC.
3. It is submitted by the learned counsel that all the co-accused persons have been released on bail by the orders of this Court. Hence, the learned



counsel for the Petitioner seeks release, inter alia, on the ground of parity.

4. Learned counsel for the Vigilance Department opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail and submits that in the meanwhile charge sheet has been filed in the case at hand.

5. Taking into account the nature of allegations and the release of the co-accused, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioner shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.

6. It is needless to state that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
