1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is the bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioners for grant of bail in connection with Titilagarh GRPS Case No. 111 of 2025 corresponding to Special GR Case No.61 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Titilagarh for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.20(b)(ii)(B) of the NDPS Act, on the main allegation of possessing 16 Kgs Grams of Contraband Ganja.
3. Heard, Ms. Mohini Sahoo, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. R.B. Mishra, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioners vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against them and regard being had to the pre trial detention of the



petitioner in custody since 12.11.2025 and no criminal antecedent being reported against the Petitioners and the quantity of Contraband Ganja allegedly seized in this case being intermediate quantity and, thereby, the provisions of Section 37 of NDPS Act being not attractable, this Court without expressing any view on merit admits the petitioners to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioners stands allowed and they are allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
