As per the order dated 12.12.2025, learned counsel for the State has produced the written instruction dated 16.12.2025 received from the Collector & District Magistrate, Ganjam, wherein it is mentioned that on receipt of the application under section 14 of the SARFAESI Act, M.C. (Bank) case no.42 of 2023 has been registered. It is also mentioned that classes are presently running in the secured assets for which delivery of possession has been sought for and in view of the ongoing academic session and in the



interest and welfare of the students, the order under section 14 of the SARFAESI Act was not passed at that stage, however, necessary steps have now been taken for grant of an order for delivery of possession of the secured assets within a fortnight. The written instruction is taken on record.
