1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is an application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Excise Station Bhubaneswar-III P.R. Case No.114 of 2025-26 corresponding to T.R. Case No.456 of 2025 pending in the file of learned 3rd Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar, for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.21(b) of NDPS Act, on the main allegation of possessing 65Grams of Heroin.
3. Heard, Mr. Rabi Narayan Mohanty, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. R.B. Mishra, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against her



and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 19.08.2025 with framing of charge in the meantime and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of the accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial and the quantity of Contraband article seized in this case being for intermediate quantity which does not attract the provision of Sec. 37 of NDPS Act, this Court without expressing any view on merits, admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the Petitioner stands allowed and the Petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) only with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deems fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
