01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard.

This is an application for bail under section 483 of BNSS in connection with Inspector of Excise, District Striking Force, Chhatrapur P.R. No.87 of 2025-26 corresponding to 2(a) C.C. No.351 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Khallikote for alleged commission of offence under section 52(a)(i) of the Odisha Excise Act.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Khallikote, Ganjam vide order dated 15.11.2025.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in judicial



custody since 01.11.2025 and he is a young boy and investigation has made substantial progress and the offence is triable by Magistrate and after hearing the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further conditions as the learned Court below may deem just and proper including the condition that the petitioner shall not indulge in any criminal activities.

Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
