- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. (POCSO) Case No.93 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Court under POCSO Act, Jeypore arising out of Jeypore Sadar P.S. No.322 of 2025, for commission of offence punishable under Sections 137(2)/64(2)(m)/87 of BNS read with Section 6 of POCSO Act.
3. Considering the nature of allegations as borne out from the statement of the victim recorded under Section 180 of BNSS, learned counsel for the Petitioners is called upon to implead the Informant as Opposite Party No.2. Consolidated cause title be filed by 23.12.2025.



Informant be noticed through the I.O.. Extra copy of the brief for the purpose be served on the learned counsel for the State by 23.12.2025 as well.

4. List this matter on 10.02.2026. Learned counsel for the State is requested to obtain the Case Diary in the meanwhile.

5. As an interim measure, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioners in connection with the aforesaid case till the next date.

In the event extra copy is not served on the learned counsel for the State, as directed, the interim order shall stand vacated.

6. It is needless to state that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.
