01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present application under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, the Petitioner seeks to assail the legality and validity of order dated 10.09.2025 passed in 1.C.C Case No.24 of 2023.
4. On perusal of the order dated 10.09.2025, it appears that the application filed at the instance of the defence under Section 91 of the Cr.P.C has been rejected only on the ground of delay that is likely to be caused in the trial. On perusal of order dated 10.09.2025, it gives an impression that the same has not been considered and disposed of on the merits of the application.
