01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. in connection with C.T. Case No.650 of 2025 arising out of Nilgiri P.S. Case No.446 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Nilgiri for offences punishable under sections 331(4)/305(a) of B.N.S.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Nilgiri vide order dated 13.11.2025.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in



judicial custody since 04.11.2025 and the offences are triable by Magistrate and the stolen cash is of Rs.15,000/- (rupees fifteen thousand), out of which Rs.13,100/- (rupees thirteen thousand one hundred) has already been recovered from the co-accused and after hearing the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with one local solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further conditions as the learned Court may deem just and proper.

Accordingly, the BLAPL is disposed of.
