1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition under Section 483 BNSS is filed for release of the petitioner on bail in connection with Special G.R. Case No.95 of 2025 pending in the file of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Nayagarh corresponding to Nayagarh P.S. Case No.424 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the copy of the FIR as at Annexure-1 and rejection order i.e. Annexure-2.
4. Recorded the objection of Mr. Swain, learned AGA. The offence has been committed by the present accused and others. In response to the above, it is informed to the Court that the co-accused, namely, Abdul Muslim Khan @ Muslim Khan @ Pinkulu has been granted pre-arrest bail in BLAPL



No.13737 of 2025. It is also informed to the Court that the petitioner is having no other criminal antecedent and he is in custody from 2nd November, 2025. Considering the same and under the impression that the substantial part of investigation is concluded, the Court is inclined to direct release of the petitioner subject to conditions.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Special G.R. Case No.95 of 2025 arising out of Nayagarh P.S. Case No.424 of 2025 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/-(rupees fifty thousand) with two solvent sureties for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Nayagarh, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper besides the following that he shall co-operate the IO in the investigation. It is further directed that the court shall allow such release subject to verification and absence of any criminal antecedent of similar nature against him.

7. The BLAPL is disposed of.
