01. 1. Mr. K.C. Nayak, learned counsel for the Appellant-Claimant and Mr. Adam Ali Khan, learned counsel are present.
2. Mr. Adam Ali Khan, learned counsel submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of Respondent No.2-Insurance Company. His Vakalatnama is not available in the case record.
3. This appeal has been filed by the Appellant-Claimant, challenging the judgment and order dated 21.05.2022 passed by the learned Addl. District Judge -cum- M.A.C.T.(III), Kendrapara in MAC Case No. 134 of 2015 directing the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company to pay an amount of Rs.9,635/- (Rupees Nine thousand Six hundred Thirty-five) only to the Appellant- Claimant alongwith interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of filing i.e. 24.12.2015, till the date of realization in shape of cheque. This Appeal has been filed for enhancement.



4. In full and final settlement of the claim, it is now agreed between the Appellant-Claimant and the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company that a modified consolidated amount of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) which includes interest, shall be paid by the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company to the Appellant- Claimant within a period of eight weeks.
5. The compromise memo signed by Mr. Kapila Charan Nayak, learned counsel for the Appellant-Claimant and Mr. Adam Ali Khan, learned counsel.
6. As Vakalatnama of Mr. Adam Ali Khan, learned counsel has not been filed, list this matter before the next Lok Adalat.
