Issue emergent notice. Learned AGA -Mr. U.C. Behura, on request of the Court, accepts notice for O.P No.1. A copy of the writ petition with all the documents be served on him within three working days.

Notice be sent to Opp. Party Nos.2 & 3 by speed post with A.D. returnable within two weeks, requisites for which shall be furnished within three working days.

An application in I.A. No.20841 of 2025 supported by affidavit is filed seeking a direction to continue the Petitioner in service, as before. Ordinarily, persons of this kind depend upon the job as the only source of livelihood and if that job is snatched, the right to livelihood may be affected in light of Apex Court decision in *Olga Telis & Ors. v. Bombay Municipal Corporation & Ors.*, AIR 1986 SC 180.



In the above circumstances, OP Nos.2 & 3 are directed to continue the Petitioner in service in usual terms as are applicable to him till next date of hearing.
