01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application for bail under section 483 of BNSS in connection with Khandagiri P.S. Case No.387 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.986 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C-V, Bhubaneswar for alleged commission of offences under section 109(1) of B.N.S., 2023 read with sections 25(1)(a)/27 of the Arms Act.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by the learned 2nd Addl. Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar vide order dated 07.11.2025.



Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.10.2025 and in the meantime, on completion of investigation, charge sheet has been submitted against the petitioner under section 109(1) of the B.N.S., 2023 and sections 25(1)(a)/27 of the Arms Act and after going through the statement of the injured, his injury report and on hearing learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further conditions as the learned Court below may deem just and proper including the conditions that the petitioner shall not try to come in contact with the injured and shall not try to tamper with the evidence and shall appear before the learned trial Court on each date to which the case would be posted for trial.

Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.



The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
