03. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing this Writ Petition, the Petitioner claiming himself to be the owner of the vehicle in question has sought for a direction from this Court to the Opposite Parties for accepting the balance 50% defaulted tax and penalty amount for re-registration of the vehicle in question.

Apart from the above, the Petitioner has also sought for a direction from this Court to the Opposite Parties for issuing necessary permit and fitness certificate in respect of his vehicle in question.

3. Heard.



4. Considering the submissions made on behalf of both the parties and since the Petitioner is ready and willing to deposit the balance 50% defaulted tax and penalty amount, this Court without going into the merits of the case directs the Petitioner to deposit the balance 50% defaulted tax and penalty amount within fifteen working days hence. In such event, the authority concerned shall accept the said amount and do the needful for redressal of grievance of the Petitioner within a period of ten working days thereafter.

5. This Writ Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
