01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. in connection with Dharakote P.S. Case No. 241 of 2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1208 of 2025 pending in the file of the learned J.M.F.C.(Cog), Aska for the offences under sections 309(6)/331(4)/317(4) of B.N.S.,2023.

The prayer for bail of the petitioners has been rejected by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Aska, Ganjam vide order dated 11.11.2025.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are in judicial custody since 24.08.2024 and they have been charge sheeted under sections 309(6)/331(4)/317(4) of B.N.S., 2023 and on hearing the learned counsel for the State, who submitted that there is one criminal antecedent of similar nature against the



petitioners, I am inclined to release the petitioners on bail.

Let the petitioners be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) each with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further conditions that the petitioners shall not indulge in any criminal activities and shall appear before the learned trial Court on each date to which the case would be posted for trial.

Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
