- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.900 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C. (Cog.), Khordha, arising out of Baghamari P.S. Case No.231 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable U/s. 191(2)/ 191(3)/ 190/ 296/ 115(2)/ 117(2) / 109(1) / 324(5) / 324(6) / 303(2) / 326(g) of B.N.S.,2023, r/w Sections 3 / 4 of P.D.P.P. Act.



3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the co-accused persons have since been released on bail by order dated 26.11.2025 by this Court in ABLAPL No.13377 of 2025. Hence, on the ground of parity, the Petitioners may be protected by pre-arrest bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes such prayer.

5. Considering the rival submission, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioners shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper subject to verification of criminal antecedent and nature of injury.

6. If it comes to fore that the Petitioner has any criminal antecedent and injury suffered by the injured is grievous, this order shall not be given effect to.

7. It is needless to state that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
