1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Party.

3. Accordingly, the matter is referred to the High Court of Orissa Mediation Centre, Cuttack.
4. Taking into account the nature of allegation and submission at the Bar, this Court requests Ms. Samapika Mishra, Advocate to act as a mediator. The fees of the learned Mediator fixed at Rs.30,000/- to be equally shared by both parties.

8. As agreed between the parties, it shall be open to the learned Mediator to explore the possibility of settlement in the cases referred to hereinabove as well as in other litigations inter se between the parties.
