01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and State.
2. Instant petition under Section 483 BNSS is filed for release of the petitioners on bail in connection with Special G.R. Case No.56 of 2025 pending in the file of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Titilagarh corresponding to Titilagarh P.S. Case No.379 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the copy of the FIR as at Annexure-1 and rejection order i.e. Annexure-2.
4. It is submitted to the Court that petitioners are having no other antecedent but according to Mr. Swain, learned AGA for the State referring to rejection order at Annexure-2, it is claimed that they are habitual offenders. The Court finds that the recovery relates to 24 Kg 720 grams which is little about the commercial quantity. Such seizure has been made from the



accused persons, who are in custody from 26th October, 2025. It is informed to the Court that the investigation is in progress and under the impression that substantial part of it to be complete in the meantime and as it is claimed that the petitioners do not have any antecedent of similar nature, the Court, considering the same and recording the objection of Mr. Swain, learned AGA for the State, is inclined to direct their release on bail with stringent conditions.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail in connection with Special G.R. Case No.56 of 2025 arising out of Titilagarh P.S. Case No.379 of 2025 subject to them furnishing a bail bonds of Rs.50,000/-(rupees fifty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Titilagarh, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper. It is further directed that such release of the petitioners shall be subject to verification and absence of similar antecedents against them.

7. The BLAPL is disposed of.
