Short grievance of the Petitioner is as to long pendency of his representation dated 17.11.2025, a copy whereof avails at Annexure-4.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that in the said representation his client has requested for release of the amount which has been unjustifiably withheld. He also submits that if a direction is issued to the OPs to consider the subject representation in a time bound way, justice would be done to him.

3. Learned AGA-Mr. Mohanty appearing for the OPs although initially opposes the petition contending that the matter like this is to be relegated to the civil suit, now very fairly agrees to instruct OP No.3 to look into the grievance of the Petitioner, as has been aired in the subject representation, in accordance with law, if a reasonable time is granted. This is appreciable.

In the above circumstances, writ petition is disposed off. Time for consideration of the subject representation and informing result of



such consideration to the Petitioner in writing, is eight weeks. All contentions are kept open.

It is open to the answering OP No.3 to solicit any information or documents from the side of the Petitioner, as required for taking a decision on the subject representation. However, in that guise delay shall not be brooked.

Now, no costs.
