01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. in connection with G.R. (Cog.) Case No.1317 of 2025 arising out of Colliery P.S. Case No.604 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C. (C.T.), Talcher for offences punishable under sections 309(6)/317(2) of B.N.S.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Talcher vide order dated 18.11.2025.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in



judicial custody since 07.11.2025 and the offences are triable by Magistrate and the allegation against the petitioner is the receiver of the stolen property and after hearing the learned counsel for the State, who submitted that there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further conditions as the learned Court may deem just and proper subject to conditions that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial Court on each date to which the case would be posted for trial and shall not indulge in any criminal activities in any manner.

Violation of any terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

Accordingly, the BLAPL is disposed of.
