01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.

3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“The petitioner therefore prays that Your Lordship’ would graciously be pleased to admit the writ application, call for the records, issue notice to the Opp. Parties and after hearing both the parties appropriate direction may be issue to the Op. No. 1,2 and 3 to take appropriate decision towards the appointment of the Petitioner as a Head and Neck Surgeon at AHPGIC, Cuttack, as he has the required qualification for the same and one Post is still lying vacant at AHPGIC, by issuing writ/writs in the nature of Certiorari/Mandamus in the greater interest of justice.

And further be please to give appropriate direction to the Op.No.3 to dispose of the representation under Annexure-3 taking in account the recommendation letter dated 15.09.2025 issued by the Op.No.4 to the Op.No. 1 under Annexure-4, in the greater inter interest of justice.”



4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the request available at Annexure-4 to the Writ Petition though is pending, but till date nothing has been done in the matter.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted request available at Annexure-4 in accordance with law, within a period of 3 (three) months from the date of receipt of this order with due communication to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
