1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition under Section 483 BNSS is filed for release of the petitioner on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.2509 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Khallikote corresponding to Rambha P.S. Case No.870 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the copy of the rejection order as at Annexure-1.
4. The accused is in custody from 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2025. It is fairly submitted to the Court by the petitioner is having other antecedents. The recovery relates to 1130 numbers of polythene pouches each containing 100 ml. of ID liquor, in total, 113 litres shown to have been made from the petitioner. As the recovery and seizure is already over with the impression that



substantial part of investigation is almost over, recording objection of the State as the quantity of ID liquor is 113 litres, the Court is of the view that the petitioner, who is in custody since the date of arrest, should be allowed to go on bail.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.2509 of 2025 arising out of Rambha P.S. Case No.870 of 2025 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/-(rupees fifty thousand) with two solvent sureties for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.F.C., Khallikote, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case besides the following, such as, in case, the investigation is still on, he shall attend the PS once in a fortnight and report the IO for the said purpose and to continue to do so till it is concluded.

7. The BLAPL is disposed of.
