1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition under Section 483 BNSS is filed seeking release of the petitioner on bail in connection with P.R. No.147 of 2025-26 pending in the file of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jaleswar corresponding to Special Case No.23 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. The petitioner had approached this Court in BLAPL No. 10219 of 2025 however, the same was withdrawn to renew the prayer for bail after examination some of the witnesses and in the meantime, a seizure witness stood examined as P.W. 1 on 17th November, 2025. No other witnesses have been examined from the side of the prosecution. Mr. Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is having no other antecedent and hence, to be released on bail. Serious objection is received from Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State to contend that good quantity of Brown sugar has been recovered and



seized from him. Admittedly, such recovery is shown as made to reveal from Annexure-1 a copy of the P.R. The seizure relates to 215 grams of Brown sugar which is less than commercial quantity. Recording the submission that the petitioner is having no other antecedent and in the meantime, with the final P.R. filed, the trial has commenced, the petitioner being a local and unlikely to abscond, the Court is inclined to allow him to go on bail with stringent conditions.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with P.R. Case No.147 of 2025-26 corresponding to Special Case No. 23 of 2025 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (rupees one lac) with two solvent sureties for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jaleswsar, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case besides the following, such as, he shall not be involved in such a nefarious activities after being released and ensuring that he is having no other similar antecedent.

6. The BLAPL is disposed of.

7. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
