Order No. 01

1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

“Under the above facts and circumstances of the case, it is humbly prayed that this Hon'ble High Court be pleased to allow this writ application by granting following reliefs:

(A) A writ of mandamus be issued directing the opposite parties particularly opp. party No. 1 & 2 to regularize the services of the petitioner as Graduate Anganwardi Supervisor w.e.f.31.03.2010 (date of joining) with all service and differential arrear benefits, instead of date order of regularization i.e.25.09.2024, after deducting the remuneration received on contractual basis within a stipulated period of time following the principles of law as laid down in the case of Subasini Das in W.P. (C) No.21977/2014 under Annexure-9 of this Hon'ble High Court.



Or in alternative and in the interest of justice, equity, any other appropriate order(s), direction(s) as deem fit may be issued, so as to give complete relief to the petitioner.

And for this act of kindness, the petitioners shall as in duty bound to ever pray. ”

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that though highlighting her grievances, Petitioner has filed a representation at Annexure-11 to the Writ Petition before the Opp. Party No. 1, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No. 1 to take a decision on the above noted Petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No. 1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law, within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
