1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition under Section 483 BNSS is filed for release of the petitioner on bail in connection with Industrial Estate P.S. Case No.266 of 2025 corresponding to T.R. Case No. 128 of 2025 pending in the file of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge under NDPS Act, Khurda on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1 and rejection order i.e. Annexure-2.
4. It is informed to the Court that there is no antecedent against the petitioner. In fact, 31 grams of Brown sugar has been recovered from the petitioner during search. Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State opposed release of the petitioner on bail. The petitioner has been arrested on 10th November, 2025



and recording the submission that has no other previous antecedent and less than commercial quantity of contraband substance is allegedly recovered from him, the Court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail with conditions.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Industrial Estate P.S. Case No.266 of 2025 corresponding to T.R. Case No. 128 of 2025 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge under NDPS Act, Khurda, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper and in the facts and circumstances of the case. The release of the petitioner, as further directed, shall be upon verification and absence of criminal antecedent of similar nature against him.

7. The BLAPL is disposed of.

8. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
