1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that she has removed most of the defects pointed out the Stamp reporter in the registry. In this regard he showed computer filing receipt acknowledgement no. 102509/25 dt. 27.11.2025. She has also filed I.A. No. 4539 of 2025 for dispensing with filing of certified copy.

Perused the Stamp reporting page and soft copy of D-WA file through online mode. Under Annexure – 1, she has filed true attested downloaded photocopy of impugned judgement dt. 31.10.2025 passed in WPC (OA) No. 363 of 2019. She further submitted that she had applied certified copy of impugned judgement. But High Court registry has not issued certified copy to her till filing of her diary W.A. case on 21.11.2025. That's why Stamp reporter has remarked it as a defect. For this reason she has filed I.A. No. 4539 of 2025



for dispensing with filing of certified copy. Also she further submitted when she queried about late in getting certified copy, Copying section staff replied her WPC (OA) file has not received from O.A. section. When she queried from O.A. section, concerned staff replied WPC (OA) No. 363 of 2019 file has not received from the concerned Court after judgment till 27.11.2025. For this reason certified copy could not be issued to the learned counsel till 27.11.2025. That's why she prayed to ignore this defect and her case be registered immediately by the High Court registry.

Put up this D-WA No. 48394 of 2025 along with I.A. No. 4539 of 2025 on 01.12.2025 under the heading "For Orders" before the assigned roster Bench for appropriate order.
