01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Learned counsel for the State submits that he has not received the case diary.

Since the offences are under sections 64 of BNS and section 4 of the POCSO Act, let an extra copy of the bail application along with all its annexures be served on the learned counsel for the State by Monday (22.12.2025), who shall send the same to the Inspector in-charge of Malkangiri Police Station for its service on the informant in (Malkangiri P.S. Case No.597 of 2025) intimating her that the matter will be taken up in the week commencing from 12.01.2026 and if she so likes, she can engage a counsel to



oppose the prayer for bail. A written proof regarding service of notice be obtained from the informant.

Put up this matter in the week commencing from 12.01.2026.

Learned counsel for the State shall obtain 183 of B.N.S.S. statement of the victim, her medical examination report, instruction regarding service of notice on the informant so also criminal antecedents, if any, against the petitioner and case diary in the meantime.

A free copy of the order be handed over to the learned counsel for the State.
