



learned ASC for the State against release of the petitioners on bail. Having regard to the facts as above and the final P.R. is at Annexure-2 and in the meantime, charge has been framed and trial is to commence and recording the submission that the petitioners are having no similar antecedents and the alleged Heroine is less than the commercial quantity, this Court is inclined to release the petitioners to go on bail subject to stringent conditions and hence, it is ordered.

4. In the result, petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail in connection with Inspector of Excise, Bhubaneswar Range-I, P.R. Case No.55/2025-26 corresponding to T.R. Case No.409 of 2025 subject to them furnishing bail bonds of Rs.1.00 lac each with two solvent sureties for the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case. The Court further directs that such release of the petitioners shall be upon verification and absence of criminal antecedents of similar nature against them.
