01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition under Section 483 BNSS is filed for release of the petitioner on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.501 of 2025 pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M., Titlagarh corresponding to Titlagarh P.S. Case No.376 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Gone through the FIR as at Annexure-1.
4. From the rejection order i.e. Annexure-2, the Court finds that the cheques were received by one of the accused persons, namely, Sebanta Bag and it was him who said to have withdrawn the amount but to return the same to the complainant but thereafter, he did not turn up, hence, leading to lodging of the report i.e. Annexure-1. It is alleged that the petitioner is involved in the conspiracy and managed withdrawal of money with the help of the above name accused.



An amount of Rs.20,000/- is shown to have been recovered from the petitioner, as further revealed from the rejection order i.e. Annexure-2. The said accused, who received the cheques, has also been arrested in connection with the case as informed to the Court. Considering the fact that the cheques were received by the co-accused and the amount was withdrawn thereafter and the involvement of the petitioner has been alleged and recovery of cash of Rs.20,000/- is shown from him, further revealed from Annexure-2, even though, the chargesheet has not been filed with the closure of investigation, considering the same, the Court is inclined to allow him to go on bail subject to conditions.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the petition under Section 483 BNSS stands allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.501 of 2025 arising out of Titlagarh P.S. Case No.376 of 2025 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.40,000/- (rupees forty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Titlagarh, who shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper and in the facts and circumstances of the case.

7. The BLAPL stands disposed of.
