1. Heard Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Instant revision is filed by the petitioner assailing the impugned order of conviction and sentence for an offence punishable under Section 447 of the I.P.C directed by a judgment of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Athgarh in Criminal Appeal No.04 of 2024 (Criminal Appeal No.124 of 2024) on the grounds stated.

Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Trial Court acquitted the petitioner of all the offences alleged against him, however, at the instance of the State, an appeal was carried to the learned Court below and it has resulted in passing the impugned order of conviction and sentence only for the offence punishable under Section 447 of I.P.C. and as a result, the petitioner has been directed to undergo sentence of one month SI and to pay a fine of Rs.100/-. In view of the above, recording the submission of Mr. Mishra,



learned counsel for the petitioner, State is directed to respond.
