- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.543 of 2025 pending on the file of learned SDJM, Kendrapara, arising out of Nikirei P.S. Case No.384 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 109, 115(2), 126(2), 296, 3(5), 304(2), 351(2), 351(3) of BNS, 2023.
3. It is submitted by the learned counsel that omnibus allegations have been made because of the inter se dispute between the family of the Petitioners and the informant as well as the family of the informant. And he also places on record the injury



reports of the injured, namely, Baburam Singh, Parsuram Singh and Pramod Singh and referring to the same submits that they have not suffered any external injury. Hence, the Petitioners may be protected by pre-arrest bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail, inter alia, on the ground that the investigation is at a nascent stage.

5. Taking into account the nature of allegations and the punishment prescribed, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioners shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper subject to verification of criminal antecedent other than inter se between the parties.

6. If it comes to the fore that the Petitioners have any other criminal antecedent than the cases inter se between the parties, this order shall not be given effect to.

7. It is needless to state that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
