1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioners in connection with G.R. Case No.1120 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C, Cog (I) Cuttack arising out of Choudwar P.S Case No.676 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the victim has not received any grievous injury. The case diary is produced pursuant to the Court's order dated 9th December, 2025. A copy of the medical examination report is also made available and on perusal of the same, the Court finds the victim received abrasions and a laceration but all are simple in nature caused by a hard and blunt object. The manner, in which, the alleged mischief has been committed by the accused persons named therein stands described by the informant, namely,



Ashok Kumar Nayak in his statement recorded under Section 180 BNSS. Considering the above facts and even though, one of such injuries is received on the head but a laceration and stated to be simple in nature and having regard to the fact that both of them are having no similar antecedents as is claimed at present, recording the objection of the State, this Court though not inclined to grant them pre-arrest bail but is of the view that they should be directed to surrender before the learned court below for being released with stringent conditions.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioners surrender before the court of learned J.M.F.C, Cog (I) Cuttack within a fortnight from today, it is directed that they shall be released on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.1120 of 2025 corresponding to Choudwar P.S Case No - 676 of 2025 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances.
