1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner, a student is before this Court being aggrieved by the action of the opposite parties particularly opposite party no.3 cancelling allotment of seat to the opposite party no.4-College.

2. It is submitted that after due process of counseling by Odisha Joint Entrance Examination Committee (2025-26) [opposite party no.3], the petitioner was provisionally allotted and was granted admission and got admitted to the course of Bachelor



in Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (BAMS). However, after the admission to the college on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2025, she has received copy of the e-mail while attending classes which has been annexed to the writ petition as Annexure-5. The said e-mail indicates that as per the instructions received from opposite party no.2 the seat allotment has been cancelled.

3. Issue notice along with this order.

Since learned CGC as well as Mr. Mishra, learned counsel have already appeared upon advance copy served, no further notice be issued to the opposite party nos.1, 2 and 3.

4. Notice be issued to the opposite party no.4 by speed post with A.D. Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days.

5. Mr. Panda, learned CGC submits that he may be provided two extra copies. One extra copy shall also be served on Mr. Mishra, learned instructing counsel appearing for OJEE.

6. Learned CGC as well as Mr. Mishra, learned counsel shall obtain instruction by the next date.
