- 1.** Heard Ms. B. Puja, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Tuna Sahu, learned counsel for the opposite party Nos.2 to 4.
 - 2.** Vide order dated 05.12.2025, this Court directed the learned Tribunal to dispose of S.A. No.68 of 2024 at the earliest, preferably by the end of January, 2026. Subsequently, the Registrar Debts Recovery Tribunal, Cuttack vide letter dated 07.03.2026 has sought extension of time for a further period of thirty days to conclude the said S.A. on the ground that the matter could not be disposed of within the stipulated time due to non-filing of the written notes by the auction purchaser and upon request of the applicant.



3. It is submitted at the Bar that the parties to the proceeding have already completed their pleadings before the learned Tribunal concerned and the next date is on 8th April, 2026.

4. Considering the above, the learned Debts Recovery Tribunal, Cuttack is directed to dispose of S.A. No.68 of 2024 in accordance with law at an early date.
