This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioner so also Mr. Rath, learned Counsel, who has appeared suo motu to represent the sole Opposite Party.

3. Though it has not been pleaded in the transfer petition, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits, after filing of this transfer petition, the Petitioner has filed two other cases apart from the P.S. Case No.200 dated 15.11.2025, lodged before the I.I.C. Patkura Police Station. The Petitioner has filed an application under Section 144 BNSS, 2023 before the learned Judge, Family Court, Kendrapara, which has been registered as CRP No.194 of 2025. Similarly, she has also filed an application under Section 12 of the Domestic Violence Act, before the learned SDJM, Kendrapara, which has been registered as D.V. Case No.172 of 2025. Accordingly, he prays for a short adjournment to file an additional affidavit.



4. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner undertakes to serve copy of the transfer petition with I.A. on the learned Counsel for the Opposite Party by tomorrow (25.03.2026).

5. At this stage, learned Counsel for the Opposite Party submits, since the Petitioner, on being noticed in C.P. No.808 of 2025, did not appear on the date fixed, she was set ex-parte and as per the instruction received, now the said C.P. stands posted to today for ex-parte hearing.

6. Accordingly, learned Counsel for the Petitioner prays for stay of further proceeding in C.P. No.808 of 2025.

7. However, learned Counsel for the Petitioner fairly undertakes before this Court that he will instruct the Opposite Party not to proceed further in C.P. No.808 of 2025 till the next date and also undertakes to move an application for adjournment before the Court below.

8. The matter be listed on 9th April, 2026, as prayed for.

9. Learned Counsel for the parties are directed to take instruction from their respective parties regarding their willingness to resolve the matter amicably through mediation before the next date of listing.
