I.A. No.7818 OF 2023

1. This is an application for condonation of delay of 46 days in filing the writ appeal.
2. It appears that the Stamp Reporter has not properly counted the period occupied by the Appellant in filing the appeal.
3. The judgment in W.P.(C) No.17510 of 2022 was passed on 03.05.2023 and the writ appeal has been filed on 26.10.2023. Hence, deducting the statutory period for filing the writ appeal, there is delay of 146 days in filing the writ appeal.
4. Mr. Biswal, learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that some inadvertent averment has been made in the limitation application. Hence, he prays for withdrawal of the limitation petition seeking liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.
5. Mr. Rath, learned Counsel for the Respondent submits that the Respondent is going to retire this month.
6. Hence, I.A. is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh petition for condonation of delay within a period of seven days hence, serving copy thereof on the learned Counsel for the Respondent.
