02. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.

2. Heard.

3. Pursuant to the order dtd.04.12.2025, learned Addl. Government Advocate for the State produced copy of the letter dtd.31.10.2025 so reflected in the impugned communication dtd.10.11.2025. Copy of the letter be kept in record.

4. Basing on the communication so produced in Court, learned Addl. Government Advocate contended that the competent authority has taken a decision that ACME Cell will no longer continue for monitoring & supervision of ANWESHA programme. Basing on such letter issued on 31.10.2025, the impugned notice in the present batch of Writ Petitions has been issued on 10.11.2025 proposing



therein to disengage all the Petitioners after completion of 30 days period.

This Court taking into account the contents of the letter dtd.31.10.2025 so produced and the show-cause issued under Annexure-1 directs learned AGA to produce the decision taken by the competent authority to discontinue the ACME Cell for the purpose of monitoring & supervision of ANWESHA programme.
