The subject matter of this petition is substantially similar to the one treated by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) No.20224 of 2021 between Chandra Sekhar Parti v. State of Odisha & Ors. heard and disposed off on 19.07.2021.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner draws attention of the Court to the Government Office Order No.19770/SSD dated 16.11.2019 at Annexure-2 which implements the order of the Orissa Administrative Tribunal in OA No.2536 of 2016 between Shri Shyamsundar Mishra v. State of Odisha disposed off on 31.07.2018. He argues that in view of all these, similar benefit needs to be extended to his client.

3. Learned AGA-Mr. Behura appearing for the OPs opposes the petition contending that certain disputable fact matrix is involved and therefore, at the most Court can direct the concerned officers to look into the grievance of the Petitioner, as has been aired in the subject representation dated 06.10.2025, a copy whereof avails at Annexure-6, which has been presented to the District Welfare Officer,



Sundargarh. Learned AGA also submits that all contentions of the parties should be kept open and reasonable period be accorded for accomplishing the task. With this proposal, counsel for the Petitioner cottons.

In the above circumstances, writ petition is disposed off. Time for consideration of the subject representation and informing result of such consideration to the Petitioner in writing, is six weeks. All contentions are kept open.

It is open to the answering Opposite Parties to solicit any information or documents from the side of the Petitioner, as required for taking a decision on the subject representation. However, in that guise delay shall not be brooked.
