1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing the present CRLMC, the Petitioners have prayed for quashing the entire Criminal Proceeding initiated against them vide Pattamundai Rural P.S. Case No.223 dated 15.06.2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No.396 of 2025 pending before the learned J.M.F.C. (Rural) at Pattamundai, Kendrapara.
3. Heard.
4. Issue Notice.
5. Learned counsel for the State waives notice on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1. Let an extra copy of the brief be served on her within three working days hence. She is directed to file reply within two weeks from the date of receipt of the brief.



6. Notice be issued to the Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post with A.D. making it returnable by 23rd March, 2026. Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days hence.

7. List this matter on 25th March, 2026.

In the meantime, if the Petitioners make a request for deferment of the proceedings before the learned trial Court, in the event the matter is listed, the learned trial Court shall consider such request and defer the matter very short, keeping in view the procrastinating conduct of the present Petitioners.
