01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present application under Section 528 of the BNSS the Petitioner seeks for a direction to the learned trial court to expedite the trial involved in 1.C.C No.410 of 2023 pending in the file of learned SDJM, Jajpur.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that the Petitioner, who is the complainant in the abovenoted complaint case, is aged about 76 years. He further contended that the occurrence out of which the present complaint case arises had occurred in the year 2023. Further, learned counsel for the petitioner had tried to persuade this Court to direct the learned trial court to expedite the trial keeping in view the advance age of



the Petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the State on the other hand contended before this Court the trial courts are burdened with a number of litigation. Therefore, giving specific direction in a particular case would not be proper.

6. Having heard the learned counsels appearing for the parties, on a careful examination of the materials on record, further keeping in view the fact that the Petitioner is aged about 76 years, this Court directs the learned trial court to expedite the trial and to make every endeavour to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible within a period of six months from the date of communication of a copy of today's order.

7. With the aforesaid observations/ directions, the CRLMC stands disposed of.
