- 01.** 1. Learned counsel, Mr. K.N. Panda has entered appearance on behalf of the Informant by filing vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.
2. Name of Mr. K.N. Panda, learned counsel for the Informant be reflected on the file, cause list as well as Web Portal of this Court.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the Informant.
4. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.731 of 2025 pending on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Dharamgarh, arising out of Golamunda P.S. Case No.191 of 2025 for



commission of offences punishable under Sections 117(2)/109(1)/3(5) of BNS.

5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that omnibus allegations have been made. Hence, the Petitioners may be protected by pre-arrest bail.

6. Learned counsel for the Informant opposes such prayer and referring to the medical documents submits that there are multiple injuries including on the scalp, left leg and hand.

7. Considering the nature of allegations, learned counsel for the State is requested to obtain the Case Diary in the meanwhile.

8. List this matter on 04.02.2026.

9. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner No.2 (Biranchi Sarap) shall not be taken into custody in connection with the aforesaid case, till the next date.

10. It is needless to state that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.
