1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Perused the kind minutes of the Hon'ble the Chief Justice at Flag-'X' assigning this Writ Appeal to be heard before a Division Bench, where Hon'ble Shri Justice M.S. Raman is a Member. Accordingly, the Writ Appeal is listed before this Bench.
3. Tracking report indicates that a packet containing notice on Respondent No.3 has been delivered in the address given in the Writ Appeal.
4. Mr. Naren Kumar Sahoo, the Appellant, who appears in person, submits that he had already served a copy of the writ appeal on Mr. Abhay Khandelwal, learned counsel, who appearing on behalf of the Respondent No.3.

Pankaj Khandelwal, Advocate and his Associates appearing for the Respondent No.3 in the cause list. Receipt showing payment of cost to the Appellant shall be filed by that date.
10. Objection, if any, be filed in the meantime positively serving a copy thereof on the Appellant.
