01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the records.
3. The present Criminal Miscellaneous Case has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to quash the entire criminal proceeding initiated against him in connection with Special Case No.71 of 2021(NDPS), arising out of Boudh P.S. Case No.308 of 2021, pending in the court of the learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Boudh.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that the Petitioner does not want to press this application and seeks



permission to withdraw the same with liberty to raise all the points at later stage by filing an appropriate application.

5. Considering such submission, this CRLMC stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as sought for.

6. Further, taking into consideration the submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Petitioner is ready and willing to appear before the trial court and cooperate with the trial, and that in the meantime some of the co-accused persons have been enlarged on bail, it is directed that if the Petitioner surrenders before the court in seisin over the matter within four weeks from today and moves an application for bail, the court in seisin over the matter shall consider and dispose of the bail application of the Petitioner in accordance with law on the same day. While considering the bail application of the Petitioner, the court in seisin over the matter shall apply the principle of parity, if the same is applicable to the facts of the present case. The Case Diary be made available to the concerned court to facilitate disposal of the bail application of the Petitioner.
