1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Alleging non-compliance of order dated 10.11.2025 passed in CRLMC No.4109 of 2025, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present contempt application.
 3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that this Court had given a specific direction in Para-6 of order dated 10.11.2025 when it was directed to comply with such direction. However, no time limit was stipulated. He further contended that despite such specific direction vide order dated 10.11.2025, the Opposite Parties have not carried out such direction.



4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid fact, this Court is of the view that once a direction has been given and there is no time stipulation in such direction, the authorities are duty bound to carry out the same within a reasonable time. The authorities are expected to sit over the order passed by this Court indefinitely. In view of the aforesaid position, this Court disposes of the present contempt application by directing the Opposite Parties to carry out the order as expeditiously as possible and report compliance to the Registry of this Court within four weeks.

5. With the aforesaid observation/direction, the CONTC application stands disposed of.
