1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard Mr. Millan Kanungo, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Petitioners. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Petitioners, at the outset, contended that the dispute involved in the F.I.R. of the present case is basically a commercial dispute. However, the Informant is trying to give such dispute in colour of a criminal case and,



accordingly, the present F.I.R. has been registered by implicating the Petitioners as an accused to put pressure on them.

4. Considering such submission as well as the documents filed along with the application, this Court is of the view that the matter requires further consideration in presence of the private Opposite Party.

5. Accordingly, issue notice to the Opposite Party No.1 and 5.

6. Since Mr. U.R. Jena, learned Additional Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1, an extra copy of the brief be served on him within three working days hence.

7. Requisites for issuance of notice to the Opposite Party No.5 by Speed Post with A.D. be filed within a week hence.

8. Office is directed to delete Opposite Parties No.2 to 4 from the cause title of the CRLMC application.

9. List this matter in the week commencing 12th January, 2026.

10. As an interim measure, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner No.1 in connection with G.R. Case No.980 of 2024, arising out of Colliery P.S. Case No.372 of 2024, pending in the court of the learned J.M.F.C. (Cog.), Talcher, till the next date.
