1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Learned State counsel submits on instructions that a decision has been taken to file a writ appeal against the judgment of this Court insofar as it relates to the present petitioner. He, however, fairly submits that no writ appeal has yet been filed.
3. This Court observes that the judgment was passed on 05.04.2025 and the matter cannot remain pending for so long for its implementation.
4. Let the Commissioner-cum-Secretary appear in person before this Court and file an affidavit stating firstly, why the judgment of this Court was not complied with and secondly, even accepting that writ appeal is to be filed, why the judgment shall not be complied with atleast provisionally. Four weeks' time is allowed.
5. List this matter on 05.08.2026.
6. It is made clear that if the judgment is provisionally complied with, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary need not appear in person.
