01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioners seek an intervention of this Court for a direction to the Opposite Party No.3 to execute the order of NBW dated 02.01.2023 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, Berhampur, Ganjam in connection with CRP No.178 of 2021.
3. As submitted by learned counsel for the Petitioners, and reveals from the case record, the learned Judge, Family Court, Berhampur, Ganjam, by order dated 26.04.2021, directed the Opposite Party-husband to pay maintenance of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand



only) per month to the Petitioner-Wife and Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) per month to the Petitioner-Son, with effect from 11.07.2018.

4. Vide order dated 12.12.2022, the learned court issued NBW against the Opposite Party for non-compliance of its order. No further step has been taken in the matter.

5. Needless to say, that the learned court passing order of NBW has to ensure its execution too, it being a judicial order and for the non-execution, adequate step can be taken by the learned court. In absence of any step taken by the court concerned, this Court is not inclined to pass any direction. The Petitioner, if so desires, may pursue the matter before the learned court in seisin over the matter to ensure the order to be executed in accordance with law.

6. The CRLMP stands disposed of accordingly.
