01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners praying for directing the Tahasildar, Mahakalapara (O.P. No.3) for making requisition to the police in order to dispose of the Demarcation Case No.253 of 2025, as some of the boundary tenants are objecting to the so-called demarcation.
3. Heard from the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Standing Counsel for the State.
4. In the **Notification No.38869 dated 13.12.2016** of the Government of Odisha, empowering the Tahasildar in Clause-5 that, Tahasildar can issue



requisition to the police thinking the requirement of presence of the police for demarcation.

5. By taking the aforesaid **Notification No.38869 dated 13.12.2016** of the Government of Odisha into account, it is felt proper to dispose of this writ petition finally at this stage giving liberty to the petitioners to approach the Tahasildar, Mahakalapara (O.P. No.3) for requisition of the police in order to dispose of the Demarcation Case No.253 of 2025.

6. As such, this writ petition filed by the petitioners is disposed of finally.
