01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing this Writ Petition, the Petitioner claiming himself to be the owner of the vehicle in question bearing registration No.OD-19-J-3288, has sought for a direction from this Court to the Opposite Parties for releasing the said vehicle which is alleged to have been detained by the Inspector in-Charge, Sadar Police Station, Cuttack/ Opposite Party No.2.
3. Heard.
4. Learned counsel for the State, at the outset, submits that in order to redress his grievance the Petitioner instead of preferring this Writ Petition, should have approached the Opposite Party No.2 at the threshold of the dispute.



5. At this juncture, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays for granting permission to the Petitioner to do so.

6. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the parties and looking to the factual scenario of the case, this Court directs the Petitioner to approach the Inspector in-Charge, Sadar Police Station, Cuttack along with all the required documents for releasing his vehicle in question within a period of fifteen working days hence. In such event, the Inspector in-charge, Sadar Police Station, Cuttack/ Opposite Party No.2 shall look into the grievance of the Petitioner and release the vehicle in question noted hereinabove as per law.

7. This Writ Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
