1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. This Interlocutory application has been filed praying for amendment of the Writ Petition.
3. On perusal of the schedule appended to the Interlocutory Application, it appears that the Petitioners by way of this amendment want to incorporate some factual aspects and the same would not change the nature and character of the case.
